Kia Noho Hāhi - Being Church: Through this theme, we will:

- Develop an understanding of the principles of Catholic Social Teaching
- Identify how we can apply these principles to our own daily lives through acts of service for others

Key Competencies:

During prayer and our programmes we have an emphasis on developing the Key Competencies: Thinking, Relating to Others, Understanding Symbols and Texts, Managing Self, Participating and Contributing

Reading Focus: Hooked on Books

- Helping children to develop their love of reading through class Novel Studies
- Exploring character traits & personalities
- Looking at different settings
- Plot (problem/solution)
- Extending knowledge of language & vocabulary
- Critical thinking & comprehension skills

Writing Focus:

- For the beginning of the term, our writing programme is linked in with our novel studies, where the children will have a chance to explore a range of different text types.
- The later part of the term, the children will have an opportunity to write their own picture/chapter books using all of the writing techniques that they have learnt over the years.

Maths - This term we will be recapping:

- Multiplication & division strategies
- Addition & subtraction strategies
- Knowledge of proportions & ratios
- Various strand topics

Spelling:

Our spelling programme (The Code) focuses on learning the different spelling patterns in the English language. This involves exploring a spelling pattern over the course of a week through a range of learning activities.

Inquiry (Science & Social Science):

This term we will be focusing on:

- Parihaka Peace
- Native Trees & Plants (Living World)

The Arts:

 Throughout the term, the Arts will be incorporated into our different units of Inquiry

Health & Physical Education:

This term we will be focusing on:

- Swimming
- Athletics
- Dealing with Change (transitions, puberty)

Home Learning Challenges: These challenges are designed to encourage creative problem solving and we expect students to complete a <u>minimum of 2 per term</u>. The emphasis is on quality, rich, creative work.
